Fundraising

Once deposits are placed we will send you a t-shirt, posters/sponsor forms and template letters for companies. Whilst we have a partner charity that supports our projects in Kenya your trip is organised through a company. This means we do not have a charity number for you to raise money for your trip but should you want to fundraise online we would recommend using a site called 'Go Fund Me' for community, not for profit fundraising. www.gofundme.com (Make sure you check their terms and conditions!)

Travel Insurance

All volunteers are responsible for ensuring that they have the correct travel insurance for their trip. Should you have any pre-existing medical issues you may need to look at getting an enhanced insurance policy to ensure you are covered.

YTA cannot take any responsibility in regards to your insurance. YTA cannot take any liability if you **do not** obtain the correct cover.

Your travel insurance must cover you for volunteering abroad. And include Kenya as a destination.

Visa

You can get a visa in advance through the Kenyan High Commission <http://evisa.go.ke/evisa.html> Should anything change regarding the Visa process and cost we will inform you beforehand. Anyone 15 and under does not require a Visa.

Health Declaration

Younique Travel Adventures requires a health declaration form from all volunteers. Please ensure you declare as much as possible to us. This includes allergies and any pre-existing medical issues. Volunteering in Kenya is demanding. Any medical concerns that you have **must** be brought to our attention prior to the trip.

Vaccinations

We recommend you start getting appointments with a doctor or travel nurse now to seek advice on what you need for your trip. Most vaccinations need to be done 4 -6 weeks prior to the trip date but this can vary.

We are not able to give medical advice but from our experience these are the vaccinations we would personally recommend you get. PLEASE STILL SEEK ADVICE FROM A DOCTOR.
