I have read and understand the following:

Project Kenya 2023 (PK23) is being organised by Somerset County Scouts Council (hereafter known as Somerset County Scouts). The proposed dates for PK23 are from the end of July 2023 for about 11 days, but I understand that these dates can only be confirmed once flights have been booked in July/August 2022. I understand that I need to be available to travel from the 28th July – 13th August 2023.

For reasons of personal safety and for the safety of others, I understand that a high standard of behaviour and respect is required during the training programme and all activities that form part of Project Kenya 2023 trip, both in England and Kenya. I understand that this trip is subject to all usual Scouting rules and guidance, including our code of practice (Young People First – the yellow card) and the Scout Association Policy, Organisation and Rules (POR). I understand that any breach of the rules will jeopardise my participation on this trip. Should I be withdrawn from the trip, due to my unsuitable behaviour, no refund will be due.

I understand that before leaving the UK, I am responsible for receiving and paying for all required vaccinations and medication as advised by my family medical practice/travel centre.

I understand this completed and signed application form for the Project Kenya 2023 trip and initial deposit must be submitted by **28th February 2022**. I understand that the viability / final cost of the trip is dependent on flight availability and that will not be known from the airlines until July/August 2023. **If things change (for reasons outside the organising team's control) then I accept that the trip may need to be amended or in worst case scenario, cancelled.**

I agree to pay the estimated cost of the trip of £2,175 and meet the published payment schedule (see below). Although there is a modest inflation of exchange rates/contingency built into the budget, any substantial price increases outside the control of the organising team (e.g. air tickets) will have to be passed on to participants; this will be at cost.

I understand the estimated cost includes: briefings; insurance (Unity Insurance Services); bus transport to/from central meeting point (Taunton/Podimore) for departure/arrival to London Heathrow Airport; international return air tickets; minibuss travel in Africa between airport, schools and activities; guesthouse accommodation in Nakuru with 3x meals a day provided; all African activities (including a Safari trip); UK training session; marketing & admin (1x international neckerchief and Union Flag badge for uniforms, 1x PK23 badge, PK23 t shirt, donations and resources for the schools in Nakuru.)

I understand the cost does not include: required vaccinations (including Covid-19 and Yellow Fever); valid passport and Kenyan visa costs; transport to/from central meeting point (Taunton /Podimore) for departure/arrival at Heathrow airport; personal clothing, equipment or spending money required for the trip; transport to/from the UK training sessions.

Stage payments:

Initial Non-Refundable Deposit £400 (28th Feb 2022); stage 2: £300 (30th April 2022); stage 3: £300 (30th June 2022); stage 4: £300 (30th Sept 2022); stage 5: £300 (30th Nov 2022); stage 6: £300 (28th Feb 2023); Final Payment £275 (30th April 2023).

I acknowledge that following my commitment to this trip, the first £400 deposit is **non-refundable**. I also understand that portions of later payments may not be refunded, if I pull out of the trip for any reason, especially where they relate to other costs that the expedition will incur on my behalf. Somerset County Scouts will provide all reasonable support to enable me to make as full a claim as possible on the travel insurance provided on my behalf.

Should I cancel my place on the trip, I understand that any money raised to cover the cost of this trip via fundraising efforts will be subject to Charity Commissioners Guidelines.
