Make your own wormery





You will need:


- 2-3 earthworms
- 1 litre clear plastic drinks bottle
- Garden soil
- · Compost
- Light-coloured sand
- · Scissors
- · Cling film and an elastic band 🚳
- Water
- · Leaves
- · Paper or card and tape

- With the help of an adult, cut the
- soil and sand in
- over the top and water until damp
- Add your worms!






- Secure cling film over the top to stop your worms escaping. Pierce with tiny holes.
- Wrap the bottle in paper to keep it dark for your worms. You can remove this when you want to have a look at how they've mixed the layers.
- Keep in a cool place and top up with water when needed. Release your worms back into the wild after you've finished your experiment.









- Build up layers of different kinds of the bottle
- Sprinkle fallen leaves
